As a 1991 foal of Nero, Space Commander has been the pride of the Richland Center area. He began his racing career as a three year old for owner Van Nelson of Lone Rock, Wisconsin. He has worked his way up the ranks of the Wisconsin racing circuit until he was of free for all caliber.

Space Commander has started one hundred and thirty seven times, returning to the winner's circle forty three times and finishing 1-2-3 in eighty-nine of those starts. He has taken a race mark of 2:01 at Maywood Park and has bankrolled over \$13,400.

Space Commander has topped the Wisconsin point standings for an outstanding five consecutive years (1995-1999) – a feat that will not be overcome for many years in the future. He was retired in 2000 after the final Wisconsin fair for that year in Viroqua. He came out of retirement briefly in 2001 for a few starts, first on the trot, then back on the pace. Commander returned to the winner's circle a few more times in 2001 but was ultimately retires again after that short campaign.
