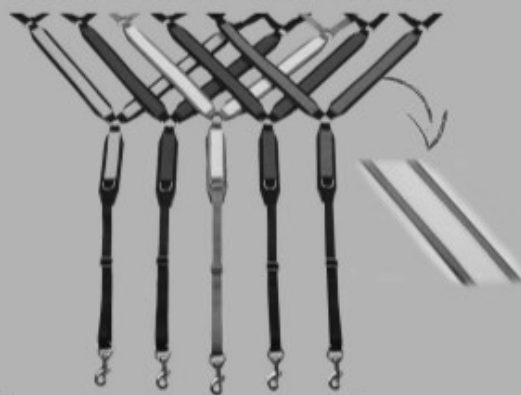

The Board Meeting was called to order at 10:30 with Susan participating by computer from Ohio. The minutes from the last meeting Oct. 25, 2015 were reviewed. Jay moved that they be accepted as read. Del seconded. All agreed.

The **Treasurer** reported that she had moved the money as suggested at the last meeting and that the checking account looks about right for this time of year. At 4:30 we need to vacate the room so that it can be set up for dinner. The menu will be similar to that which we enjoyed 2 years ago. The hotel will do the service, breaks and dessert.

There will be newsletter prior to the meeting containing registration and membership forms, an application for bidding numbers, raffle tickets for the Featherweight harness, and a request for nominations to WHHA board.

**Awards** have been determined as follows: Service Awards will be given to Butch and Ann Douglas for providing reliable starting, to the Alexander crew for the successful Westfield Meet, and to 15 year old Derek Bromac N for being a great ambassador. ## Jim Coulter

James "Jim" Coulter, 85, of New Sharon, Iowa, died Dec. 14, 2015, at the Crystal Heights Care Center in Oskaaloosa.



Mr. Coulter was born Sept. 13, 1930, in What Cheer, Iowa, the son of Warren and Marie Grudgings Coulter. He was a 1948 graduate of What Cheer High School. While a senior in high school he enlisted in the Iowa National Guard so he could continue to help his parents on their farm.

On Sept. 29, 1951, he was united in marriage to Lenora McCulley at the Little Brown Church in Nashua. Soon after the couple started a family and began buying farmland.

In 1959 Mr. Coulter purchased two broodmares from his father and began his lifelong passion as an owner, breeder, trainer and driver of Standard-breds. Over time both Mr. Coulter and his father earned a spot in the Iowa Harness Horse Hall of Fame.

In 1983 Mr. Coulter was instrumental in lobbying Iowa legislators to bring pari-mutuel racing to Iowa. It was important to him that people knew harness racing was an honest, family oriented business that most any family could enjoy together.

Over the years he served as a director of the United States Trotting Association District 4, Iowa Harness Horsemen's Association, Hawkeye Colt Association, Southern Iowa Fair and the Keokuk County Fair.

He was past president of the Midwest Racing Circuit and North Mahaska School District School Board. He also served as Adams Township Trustee and was a member of the Lacey United Methodist Church.

Of all the positions he held over the years, being a devoted husband to his wife meant the most to him. By simply loving and respecting his best friend of 64 years his children developed respect, admiration and love for their father. He loved his children and grandchildren, who to this day refer to him as "Bunker," enough that he never hesitated to give praise or a little tough love if need be.

Mr. Coulter will be remembered by many as an honest, humble, hardworking man whose presence made the world a better place.

He is survived by his wife, Lenora; daughters, Diana (Randy) Fuqua and Janna (Jim) Hawkins; son, Rodney (Victoria); sisters, Jeannine Duncan and Dottie Behrens; brother, Dan; six grandchildren; and three great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents; infant sister, Barbara; sister-in-law, Annette; and brothers-in-law, Glenn McKain and Elmer Behrens.



## Orriene Magee Buckley

The Journey and Destination of Tattler's Jet The numbers are inconceivable, but in reality they are believable. Four hundred and sixty two lifetime starts, one hundred and twenty wins, a sub two minute win in 1:49 and 2. The endurance and stamina, coupled with blood lines, patience, preparation and opportunity were the recipe that made Jet's career a reality. Explaining a mile in 49 and two by a twelve year old gelding with all those miles at all those venues and all the shipping around the country remains a puzzle. Had Tattler's Jet paced his sub 1:50 mile as a three year old at the Meadowlands, Woodbine, Hoosier Downs or Springfield, or any of the venues where records are made to be broken, then it would be understandable. But no, it was in an overnight at Virginia's Colonial Downs. It was the "trip" that an owner with trust, a trainer with confidence, a driver with patience, and a twelve year old horse with heart that shocked the tele timer and the sport of harness racing.

#### Twelve years earlier...

Dave and Jane Carter of Eau Claire, WI got a call from Hall of Famer, Del Insko. The message was "both your mares foaled and the babies are fine." A few months earlier Dave dropped two mares off at the Insko Farm in South Beloit, Illinois to foal. One of the mares was a Ralph Hanover mare named "Jodhpurs" that David Carter bred to Tattlers Torpedo. David preferred Illinois breds; Wisconsin purses were small and the Minnesota colt stakes were years from fruition.

The Carters previously owned a few thoroughbreds over the years, but harness racing was more attractive as it allowed David to be more than an owner. The trotters and pacers allowed him to train and drive his own horses. Their farm outside of Eau Claire, Wisconsin is large enough to raise colts and as well as train them on their own track.

Tattler's Jet's two year old season was limited to just one start. As a three year old he raced a bit more but was accused of being "lazy." David lamented that "he just liked to follow the other horses." Jet eventually qualified at Canterbury Park in Shakopee, Minnesota and finished third in his next start. Those efforts proved to be enough to earn him another year and another chance to be part of the Carter Stable.

Dave eventually turned "Jet" over to his friend Gene Miller out of Charlotte, Michigan. Gene was doing a great job with David's future Hall of Fame trotter, Crafty Sailor, so why not see how he would do with Tattler's Jet? Gene's philosophy in racing horses is simple: "They don't lay eggs, you can't milk them, so why not race them," and race Tattler's Jet he did. Miller made sure this now aged pacer had time to rest, was turned out

between races, and kept fresh in spite of his hectic schedule. Over the nine years with Miller, he averaged over 40 starts a year. Miller raced him where he belonged and where he could get checks. Tattlers Jet took trailer rides covering 53 venues, seven states, and Canada. The starts, wins and age were under the media radar until Gene entered him in the Au Revoir at Monticello Raceway, in New York. The New York Times, one of our nation's top daily papers with almost two million daily customers, got wind of this little known invader from the Midwest. Move over New York Jets, Giants, Nets, and Rangers. Yes, the front page sports story about three old campaigners, Dave Carter, Gene Miller, and of course Tattler's Jet is a must read. It will warm your heart and remind you why "The Sport of Kings" still has room for the little guy.

#### Life after Retirement for the Ambassador

Jet relaxes six days a week, but on Sunday, the Running Aces' fans get a chance to ride behind him between races. Race goers love it; they stuff the entry box hoping their names will be drawn to sit behind their new harness hero. And, unlike many of his fellow "old timers," Jet is not intimidated or afraid of the world of social media. He may be the only horse with his own Facebook account. Fans send him messages at will and he (??) responds ASAP. Jet includes pictures documenting his busy schedule at Running Aces. Not too shabby for that lazy horse.

Tattler's Jet, call him the iron horse, war horse, ambassador, old campaigner, etc., it is now time to call this Standardbred race horse a "Hall of Famer" and add his legacy to the equine category of the Wisconsin Harness Racing Hall of Fame on January 23, 2016. Jet, thanks for the memories.

WHHA President Gabe Wand has chosen long time horseman Orval Bronkhorst of Brandon, WI as the recipient of the 2015 Horseperson of the Year Award. Orval has a harness racing career dating back into the 1960s and 1970s, and predominately has raced at the fairs in Wisconsin and Illinois. Orval is the son of Wisconsin Harness Racing Hall of Fame inductee, Elmer Bronkhorst.

Orval has always maintained a small racing stable, consisting only of 1-2 trotters, as this was his love. He enjoyed developing his trotting hands and horsemanship over the years and has conditioned many young trotters that brought joy to him and his wife Pat. Throughout the years, Orval has garnered nine Top Ten Trotting awards in Wisconsin, including the 1989 Runner-Up Trotter of the Year, Honorable Edition.

As a driver, Orval has been in the WHHA Top Ten Drivers twice, beginning with the 1989 Top Ten inaugural season. He has posted over 100 wins and well over \$100,000 in driving earnings, which is not a small feat for someone driving at the county fairs.

Some of Orval's greatest prodigies included sub-2:00 trotters, LF Gran Falls (1:55.3, \$30,151), Jet Flow (1:57.2, \$34,079) and his greatest trotter of all, Highmaker (1:55, \$159,489).

Dressed in his red and grey racing silks and sitting in his shiny red Jerald race bike, Orval is a figure of quiet authority both on and off the race track.

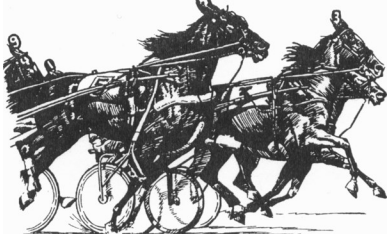
