
### **Message from the President**

### An Announcers Anniversary

My father, O.L. "Buck" Weaver, has been announcing horse races throughout the Midwest for 55 years. He announced his first race in July of 1957 in Seymour, WI. Recently, I asked him to tell me about his life in Seymour, and how he came to announce the races there.

Les, or Lester, as he was known back then, moved to Seymour in 1951, to teach high school social studies. He taught and coached there for ten years before moving on to other pursuits. While in Seymour, he rented a room from Mrs. Shepherd, whose distant relative, Marion, served as speed superintendent in Seymour for a number of years. Although my father does not remember with certainty when friends and racing fans began to call him Buck, he knows it came about after his first announcing job.

When he had nothing else to do, Dad used to hang out in the tack room at the Seymour fairgrounds. He became friends with Marion Shepherd and Stew Bodine, who was the presiding judge. Periodically, Dad would call mythical horse races in the tack room. (When I teased him about his, he reminded me that as a little girl, I used to run laps around our circular driveway, calling horse races between "Sticky Glue" and "Pacing Pauline." Point taken!)

By 1957, Wayne Jensen had replaced Marion Shepherd as superintendent of speed. That summer, Ralph Davis, who had been the announcer at Seymour, had a disagreement with the fair over payment on a rainout. Wayne Jensen offered Dad the job. When asked to assess his performance that first day, my father replied, "Good enough to get rehired the next year."

Dad remembers average sized fields of horses and a decent crowd in the grandstand. He also remembers some of the performers. Hugh and Elwood Magee raced that day. Their horse, Mr. Red Hunter, eventually won 99 races in Wisconsin. Bob Linskins, John Brick, Bob Van Schyndel, and Don Vercuteren also competed. Roy Gettman raced Warren Heberling, a decent fair pacer. Gettman and his wife spent winters in a veteran's home, but during the summer months lived in tack rooms. John Hussin raced that day as well. Interestingly, his blanket rack now hangs in our horse trailer, purchased at an auction by my brother, Wayne.

When asked the origin of some of his catch phrases, Dad cited Stan Bergstein in Chicago and Perry O'Brien. Perry announced races in Elkhorn, Monroe, Belvidere, and Woodstock, among other places.

Dad also remembers some of officials he worked with at Seymour. As mentioned, Stew Bodine was the judge. Hermie Husman was the clerk for racing, and Smiley Nikodem served as chief timer. Recently, my father began making a list of all the presiding judges with whom he's worked. There are close to 50 names on the list and just as many stories to accompany them, but we will save that for a later issue.

Jack Kissinger was the horseshoer at Seymour. Even though he was from Seymour, he shod many horse in the Green Bay and DePere areas. In addition, he made shoes from hoof patterns sent to him in the mail. When he was finished, he would mail back the completed shoes.

During the summer of 1957, my father also announced his first horse race in Illinois. Charlie Haight, who was scheduled to announce at Aledo, was killed by a train. Dad was asked to replace him.

### WISCONSIN HARNESS RACING HALL OF FAME

### **Guidelines for Nomination**

#### IMMORTAL CATEGORY

- A. Nominee must be deceased a minimum of five years.
- B. Should have contributed significantly to Wisconsin harness racing as a breeder, an owner, a trainer, or a driver and/or through organizational leadership, or should have achieved national prominence in one of the foregoing categories and have significant Wisconsin attachments.
- C. Multiple nominees can be inducted each year but it is not mandatory to induct someone every year.

### **LIVING CATEGORY**

- A. Should have contributed significantly to Wisconsin harness racing as a breeder, an owner, a trainer, or a driver and/or through organizational leadership, or should have achieved national prominence in one of the foregoing categories and have significant Wisconsin attachments.
- B. Multiple nominees can be inducted each year but it is not mandatory to induct someone every year.

#### **HORSE CATEGORY**

- A. Horse may be living or deceased.
- B. The performance of the horse should be viewed as exceptional when compared to other horses competing in the industry at the time. Nominee should have achieved prominence in racing or reproduction and should have done so (in part, at least) in Wisconsin.
- C. Multiple nominees can be inducted each year but it is not mandatory to induct someone every year.

#### **FAMILY CATEGORY**

- A. Any Wisconsin family encompassing at least three (3) generations of active participation in harness racing with a positive impact.
- B. Multiple nominees can be inducted each year but it is not mandatory to induct families every year.
